Rules and regulations:

Each artist may enter up to 3 pieces of artwork. Each work of art should have its own entry form. Minors must have a parent signature.

Entries can be made from any medium, and may be 3D, 2D, or if you really want to amaze us, 4D.

Entries should depict art that is appropriate for public consumption, understanding that people of all ages will be viewing this exhibit. Library staff will have the ultimate say in what can or cannot be displayed.

All entries will be available for pick-up beginning on **Friday, August 23**, and must be picked up by **Friday, September 20**. **Any unclaimed entries will be recycled by library staff. You may retrieve your piece at the Adult Check Out desk during this time.**
