- Minors must have a parent signature.
- Artwork and entry forms can be emailed to coeurdcon@gmail.com or turned in at the adult checkout desk.
- Digital artwork should be in .JPG, .JPEG, or .PNG format and should be under 25 MB in size. (Photos may be resized to fit the online voting ballot.)
- Artists should follow all legal restrictions of copyright and fair use.
- Entries can be made from any medium, and may be 3D, 2D, or 4D.
- In order to claim prizes, entrants must be local and able to travel to the Coeur d'Alene Public Library.

Coeur d'Con is a family-friendly event, and as such, your entry must be appropriate for attendees of all-ages, and should not include indecent exposure, gratuitous violence, obscene gestures, racist representation, or other Adult content. Coeur d'Con staff have the final say about whether art is appropriate or not, and they have the authority to reject an inappropriate submission.
